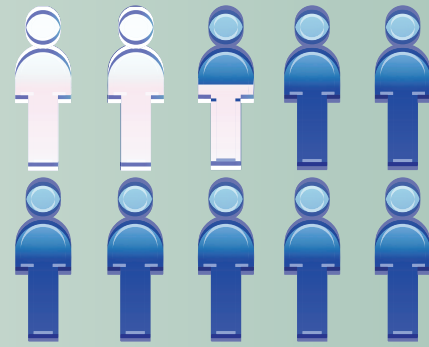

TECHNOLOGY

NEW TO RADIOLOGY

ZENITION C-ARM

This machine allows x-rays to be taken in the operating room during a surgical procedure. The new Philips Zenition is a vast improvement over the previous Philips C-Arm ERMC purchased in 2008. This new machine upgrades surgical imaging to a digital platform. The Zenition C-Arm has vastly superior image quality and a much larger field of view.

The digital c-arm also allows for additional software packages to be added to expand the variety of cases that can be performed at ERMC. It also uses less radiation than the previous analog c-arm which makes it much safer for patients and staff.

NEW TO LAB

COVID PCR ANALYZER



This analyzer is the first of its kind in the area. This technology allows the hospital to receive COVID-19, Influenza A and B, and RSV results onsite in hours compared to days. It enhances patient care, assists physicians in providing appropriate treatment sooner, and allows for quicker transfers and accurate bed placement within the medical surgical department.



NEW TO SURGERY

MAZOR X STEALTH™ EDITION ROBOT

Eaton Rapids Medical Center (ERMC) recently announced the addition of a brand new spinal surgery robotic guidance platform in their surgical department.

The Mazor X Stealth™ Edition Robotic Guidance System is currently available at only a small number of spinal and orthopedic hospitals across the United States, making ERMC among the first to offer this innovative surgical technology to patients.

With precision and accuracy, the Mazor X Robotic Guidance System assists neurosurgeons in performing lumbar fusion procedures. Without the assistance of this technology the procedure can take upwards of nine hours, with robot assistance it can be completed in less than four. Robot-assisted surgeries also result in shorter hospital stays, less tissue damage, and expedited recovery times.

ERMC, in partnership with McLaren Cardiovascular Associates, has extended cardiology service hours.

This expert team of heart specialists includes Dr. Shaw, M.D., Dr. Madalla, M.D., Dr. McComb, D.O., Jessie McWaters PA-C, Emily Van Hoogstraal, NP-C, and an excellent crew of support staff.

Patients now have more access to innovative treatment options for heart attacks, cardiovascular disease, congestive heart failure, and more. This includes increased coverage for echocardiograms and vascular testing for inpatient, outpatient, and emergency services.

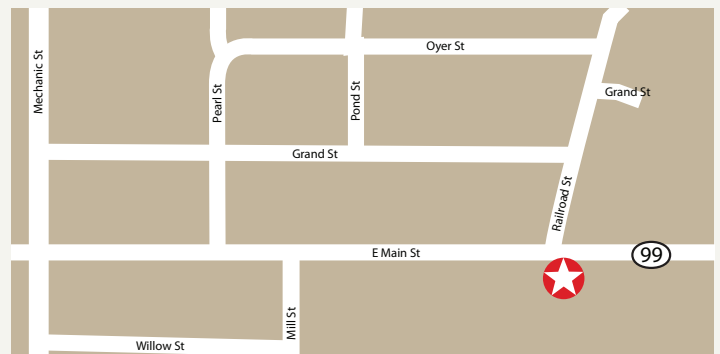

EXCELLENCE IN CARE

ERMC RANKED #2 BEST HOSPITAL IN MICHIGAN FOR OUTSTANDING PATIENT EXPERIENCE



EATON RAPIDS MEDICAL CENTER (ERMC) HAS BEEN RANKED SECOND IN THE STATE OF MICHIGAN FOR DELIVERING BEST-IN-CLASS PATIENT EXPERIENCE.

The hospital was recently awarded the 2022 Outstanding Patient Experience Award by Healthgrades, an organization that researches and compares healthcare providers across the country. ERMĆ's ranking on this list officially marks it as one of the top hospitals in the nation, and the second-best hospital in the state of Michigan, for overall patient experience.

Patient experience measures tell you how patients felt about the care they received at the hospital. These measures are based on the Hospital Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (HCAHPS) survey data from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Healthgrades bases its rankings on nine specific measures related to doctor and nurse communication, hospital cleanliness and noise levels, and medication and post-discharge care instructions.

For this annual analysis 3,173 hospitals were evaluated using data collected from HCAHPS surveys and the top 15% across the nation were recognized as prioritizing and excelling in patient experience.

5-STAR PATIENT EXPERIENCE



ERMC has again been rated a 5-star patient experience by the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). "It says a lot about our staff, that despite higher volumes we remain one of the top-rated hospitals in patient satisfaction in the country," said Heather Schragg, Director, Patient Experience.

ERMC remains the only 5-star hospital for patient experience in the Greater Lansing area.



LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

Eaton Rapids Medical Center (ERMC) nurses Carol Hamilton, RN and Linda Reid, BSN, RN, both received the DAISY Lifetime Achievement Award.

The DAISY Award for Extraordinary Nurses was created by the DAISY Foundation to honor nurses who go above and beyond to make a difference in patients' and families' experiences in healthcare.

Reid, who is now "semi-retired" but continues to work with ERMC leadership to guide and shape patient care, served the Eaton Rapids community as a registered nurse for more than 41 years treating more than 63,000 patients in that time.
