Eaton Rapids Medical Center Wound Clinic is an all-encompassing, full-service outpatient facility providing advanced wound care for patients presenting with a variety of non-healing wounds including diabetic foot ulcers, compromised tissue flaps/grafts and, bony or soft tissue wounds resulting from radiation treatment.






